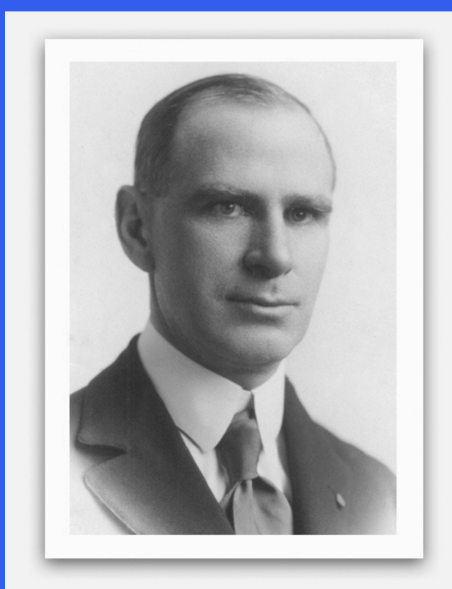

The Davidson Prize



ASABE has partnered with the Association of Equipment Manufacturers to create an award to recognize extraordinary innovation in agriculture. Davidson Prize winners represent the diversity of agricultural engineering, as well as the variety of organizations that continue to bring advanced technology and exciting improvements to the marketplace.

From the ten AE50 winners receiving the highest scores, a panel of judges selects up to three products determined to be the most innovative and most likely to have significant impact on agricultural production, efficiency, or safety. Judges will use the AE50 submission materials in making their selections.



The Davidson Prize is named for J.B. Davidson, the father of modern agricultural engineering, who would be amazed at how advanced agricultural production systems have become. The Davidson Prize gives a nod to the storied past of agricultural engineering and pays homage to those engineers, like J.B. Davidson, who aspire to find a better way.
