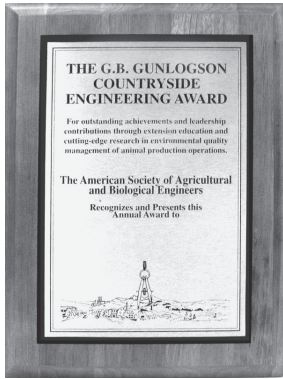


Technological Contributions Awards
