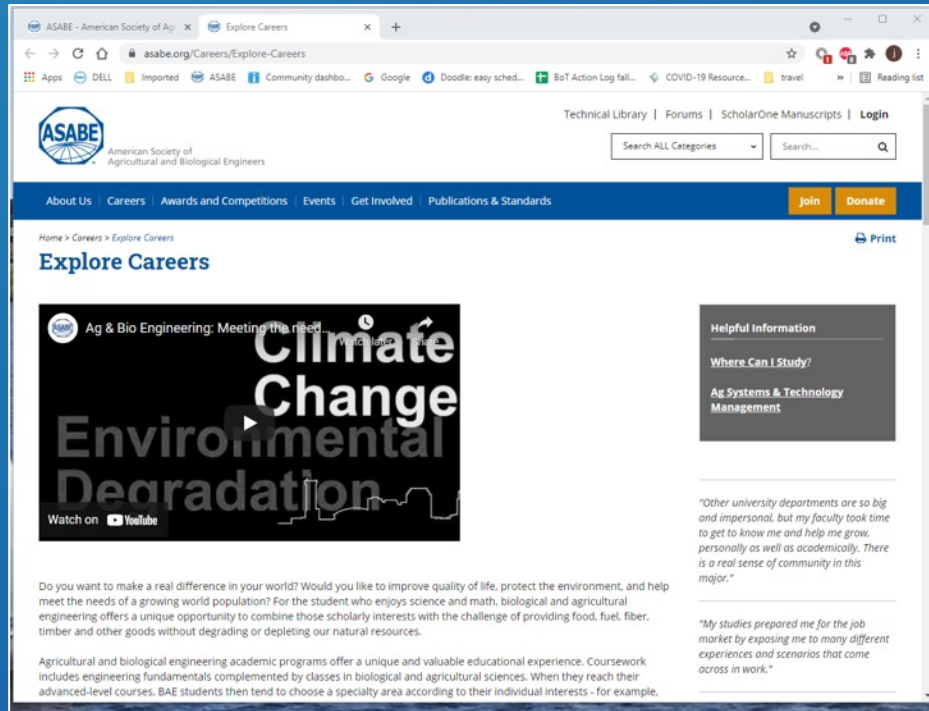


International Student Branch (ISB)

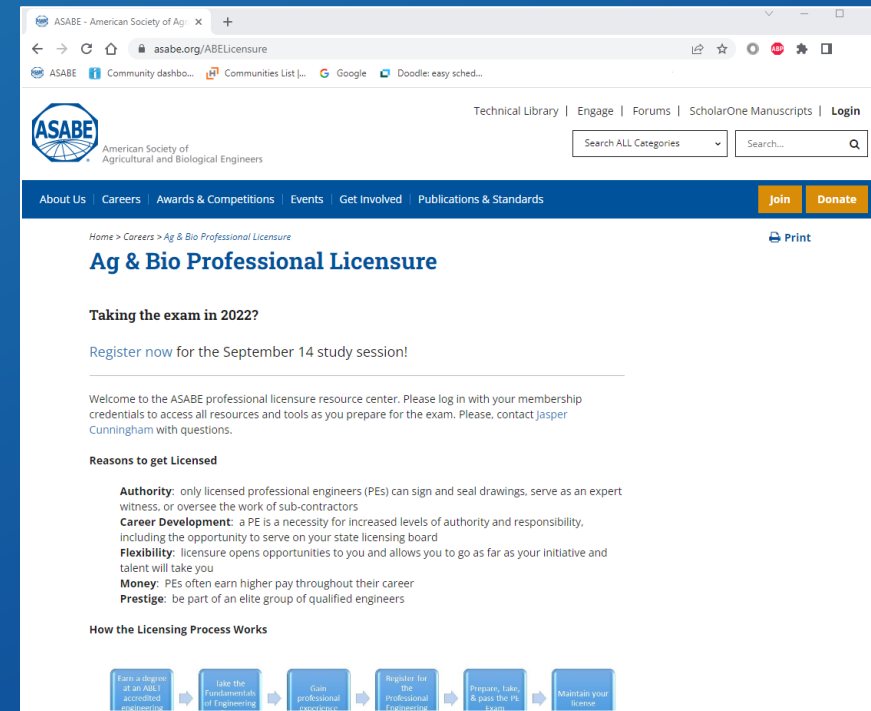
- Student members are governed by the International Student Branch (ISB) officers, who are elected annually by their peers. They serve one-year terms.
